Student Learning Outcomes for the B.A. in Individual Major

Students completing the Individual Major in the School of the Arts and Architecture should be able to:

- design a course of study showing a deep understanding of how the disparate disciplines from which they have drawn their Major course work are connected.
- demonstrate an understanding of how the research and creative methodologies of different disciplines or artistic genres can interface with and illuminate the understanding of another.
- demonstrate the ability to read in the scholarly discourse and style of different disciplines and find a voice in their written thesis that speaks to an interdisciplinary audience.
- write a thesis that demonstrates mastery of the diverse fields and imagination that have been explored as a result of seeking knowledge and research sources, and of producing scholarly and creative work, outside of traditionally defined academic boundaries.
- produce a final paper or creative project which synthesizes and integrates a principal theme or themes common to the courses and diverse fields of knowledge comprising the major.
